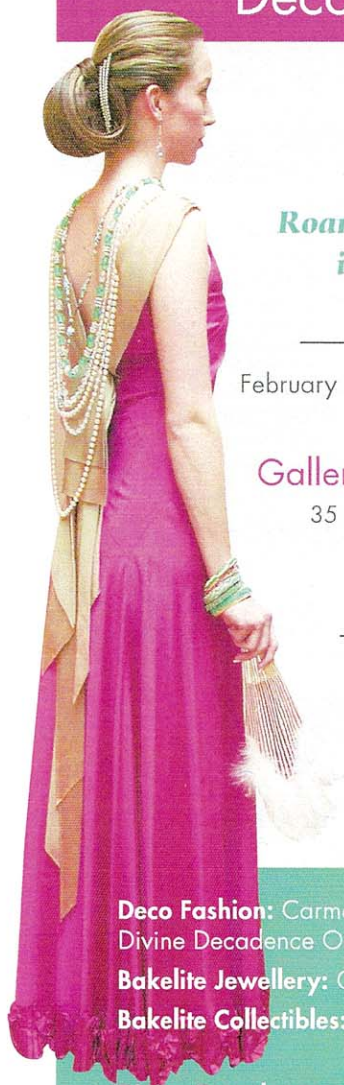

Jewellery

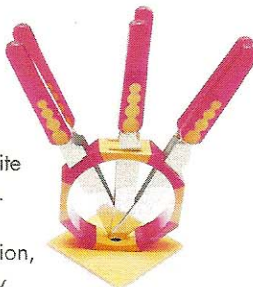
